



Introduction

White Rock Springs Peak is the large mountain that is separated from the main mass of the Red Rock escarpment by Willow Springs. The main attraction from a climbing point of view is the excellent northeast face, called the Angel Food Wall, which has some great moderate routes which get a lot of shade. More recently, quite a few single pitch routes have come to light in and around White Rock Springs. In particular, The Enclaves has some very high-quality short routes on beautiful varnish.

Access

Depending on where you are climbing there are several parking places for White Rock Springs. The parking area at the end of the White Rock Springs spur road is most useful for Angel Food Wall and the Enclaves. A small pullout on the main loop directly below Sheep Skull Crag is useful for that cliff as well as Ledger Crag. If that parking is unavailable these cliffs can easily be reached from the Lost Creek parking area in Willow Springs.
